WHAT'S ON AT AMBERLEY MUSEUM

Vintage Car Show – Sunday 11th April 2010

Over 200 of the finest vintage cars will be attending the Vintage Car Show at Amberley Museum on Sunday 11th April. This annual spring event marks the start of the new rally season for many enthusiasts with an opportunity to dust off the winter cobwebs and enjoy a scenic road run to the Museum, which is situated within the South Downs National Park.

The oldest vehicle will be the 1899 Pope Waverly electric car owned by Harrods, the famous London store, and the sustainable transport theme will also be exhibited by the impressive 1911 Stanley steam car, owned by Jeff Theobald from Haslemere, Surrey.

Each year the show attracts a superb group of large sporting cars from the 1920s to 1930s. Sunbeam, Lagonda, Talbot, Bentley and Alvis are all testimony to what was probably the finest period of classic British touring cars.

A selection of post 1945 classic vehicles will bring back memories of early family outings for many visitors. Ford Populars, Jowett Javelins, Austin Somersets and Morris Minors are just some of the entries.

Event organiser and Museum Trustee, Brian Johnson comments: "This year's event has an excellent entry list to show private motoring in the first half of the twentieth century in keeping with many of the permanent exhibitions at the Museum. Vintage bus and steam train rides will complement the cars in providing a nostalgic day out for all the family."
