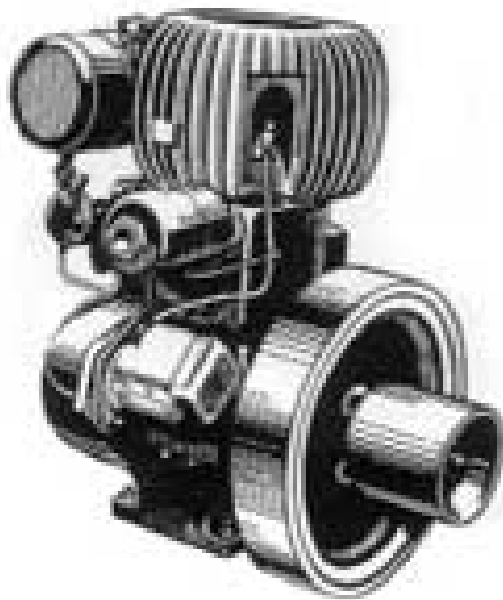

WOLSELEY engines

WELCOME to the annual Stationary Engine Working Day at Amberley Working Museum. Today we have a grand assembly of oil, gas and hot-air engines that were so popular on farms and in workshops between the 1880s and the 1940s, before mains electricity was widely available in rural areas. These engines did much of the work that is now done by electric motors, including pumping water, driving machine tools, powering saws and running farm machinery, and today many of the engines on display will be demonstrating this work, driving appropriate vintage machinery.

Each year this event has a special feature display. For 2008 we are highlighting engines made by the Wolseley Sheep-Shearing Machine Company and its descendants.

Engines have been brought along for this event by enthusiasts from throughout the South-East, and in some cases from well outside the region. The Museum is very grateful to all the engine owners for their support, and also to our volunteer event organiser for today, Ian Sampson.
