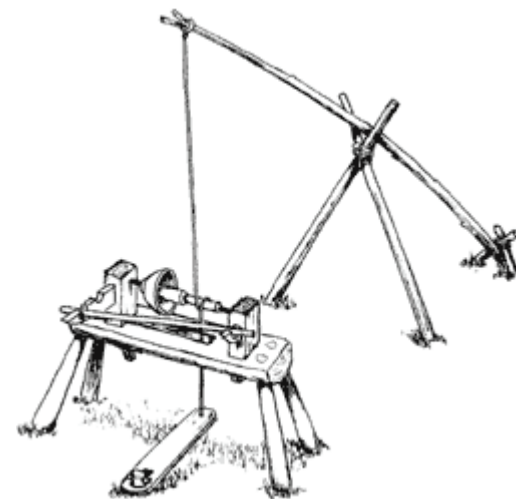

**Special working of the Museum Timberyard**, featuring:

Regular demonstrations of the **rack saw bench**, formerly of the Hyde Estate, Handcross, by George Stringer and others

The bench will be driven by the **1925 Burrell Steam Traction Engine** of Neil Gough. This engine spent all its working life with one owner in the Diss area of Norfolk, and was restored by Derek Kilburn of Worthing, with the present owner carrying out further work since.

There will also be regular demonstrations of the **1937 Smiths rail-mounted steam timber crane**, in the hands of Norman Flexman.

The **Mercedes Unimog timber tractors** of John Harraway and Joseph Payne will also be on display.

**Other Museum Craftsmen and Volunteers** will be demonstrating in their various locations:

Walking Stick Maker – demonstration of **walking stick making** by Ray Babbage.

Broom Maker – demonstration of **besom broom making** by Arthur Haffenden.

Print Shop – display of **wooden printing blocks and block engraving tools**.
