

Part-time Cleaner and Facilities Assistant Job Description

Amberley Museum receives around 50,000 visitors pa and is located by Amberley Station, near Arundel in West Sussex. We are looking for someone who is friendly, hard-working and reliable to cover our cleaning duties and be an assistant to our Facilities Officer on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, with overtime potentially available on other days of the week. Your responsibilities will include regular cleaning of some of our exhibition areas, toilets and public areas of the Café, emptying waste bins and assisting with the upkeep of our 36 acre site.

We like to ensure that our visitors have a great time when they are with us and we are looking for someone who will take pride in their work and be part of a small staff team that runs the Museum with the help of over 300 volunteers. A driving licence would be an advantage for the collection of waste in the site van. The salary is £8.91 per hour and the hours are 9am-5pm. Application is by submission of CV and covering letter by the 8th August.
