

## Make your own train and/or bus tickets

*This activity pack includes:*

- **A4 sheet of ready-to-print train tickets**
- **A4 ticket template**
- **2-page learning resource: Train tickets from 1890s to the present day**  
This includes some images from our Museum archive and can be used in any way you wish in the classroom.

### Activity idea 1: Ticket detectives

Imagine you find a ticket lying on the ground in a busy station. You have no idea who it belongs to. How much can you find out about the owner from the ticket?

### Activity idea 2: Find your ticket team

Cut up and distribute the four tickets from the 1890s so that each child has a ticket. Get the children to mingle and share the information on their cards so they end up in four groups, one per card. Helpful prompts from the teacher could include:

- Who is the ticket for?
- How much did it cost?
- Where did they come from / where are they going?
- How are they travelling (which class)?

### Activity idea 3: Train travel through time

Look up the journeys on the tickets online using a planner such as [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk), [www.traveline.info](http://www.traveline.info) or [www.google.com/maps](http://www.google.com/maps). Compare journey prices, times and travel options. Do all of the stations still exist? What might the alternatives be?

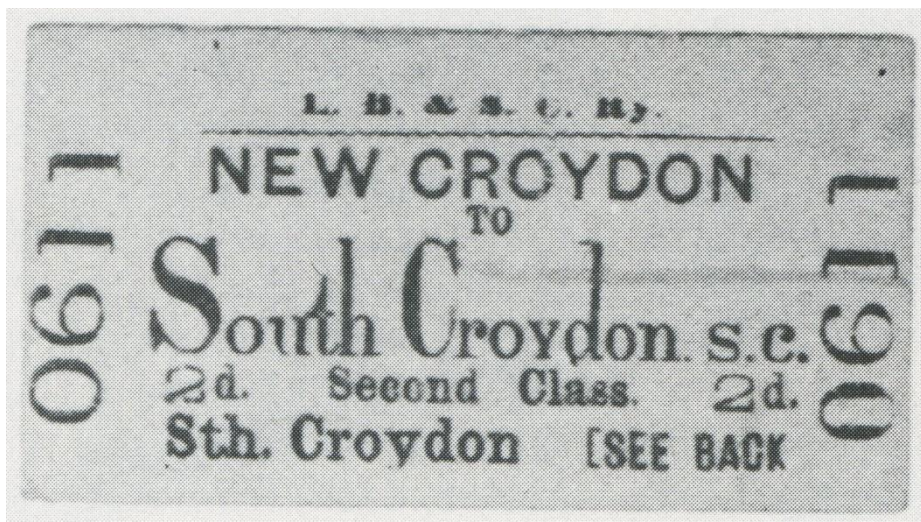
